Here in Minnesota, we have about 12 months with above freezing temps and a fairly high amount of precipitation. Sure, there will always be a warm or cold spell, but that is part of the reason the climate is beautiful. We conducted a meta-analysis of studies published to date to summarize current evidence on the efficacy of moxifloxacin, compared to norfloxacin in the eradication of Helicobacter pylori infection. Electronic searches were conducted of MEDLINE and EMBASE up to December 2003. Randomized controlled trials of moxifloxacin vs. norfloxacin in patients with H. pylori infections were included. Studies were eligible for analysis if the treatment regimen was either 7 days or 10 days of treatment, moxifloxacin was administered as a single dose, or comparator was administered for 7 days and then switched to moxifloxacin for the last 3 days. Seven studies were eligible for inclusion (n=
