

Masters Dissertation - Guide 2022

During the course of your Msc dissertation, there are several things that you need to keep in mind. These things are: conducting a literature search, writing a literature review, formatting [dissertation help service](#) dissertation report and correcting writing mistakes.

Write a literature review

Often written in the sciences, a literature review is a critical evaluation of prior research. It identifies gaps in knowledge, and suggests new directions for further research.

Writing a literature review requires a [cheap dissertation help](#) to conduct a thorough search for relevant information. Students can organize the literature review around a theme, key theoretical approach, or a methodological approach. This will demonstrate their critical thinking skills, as well as their ability to relate their own research to prior work.
